

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. "Package Rate shall mean and include lump sum cost of inpatient treatment daycare which a UPRVUNL beneficiary has been permitted by the competent authority or for treatment under emergency from the time of admission to the time of discharge including (i) Registration charges, (ii) Admission charges, (iii) Accommodation charges (iv) Operation charges (v) Injection charges, (iv) Dressing charges, (vii) Doctor/Consultant visit charges,(xi) Anesthesia charges, (xii) Operation theatre charges,(xiii) Procedural charges/Surgeon's fee,(xiv) Cost of medicines,(xvi) Related routine and essential investigations,(x vii) Physiotherapy charges etc.(xviii) Nursing care and charges for the services.
 2. Cost of implants is reimbursable in addition to package rates as per UPRVUNL ceiling rates for implants or as per actual, in case there is no prescribed ceiling rates.
- 2.1 IMLPLANTS includes Nails, Plates, Joints, Shunts, MESH, Intra Ocular Lens, Pace Maker etc.
3. Treatment charges for new born baby are separately reimbursable in addition to delivery charges for mother.
 - 4.(a) The maximum room rent for different categories (as specified in order No.641 dt. 24.4.09) :-
General Ward – Rs. 100/- day
Semi Private Ward Rs.200/- day
Private Ward –Rs.300 /- day (Non A.C.)
Private Ward –(A.C.)-Rs.600/- day.
 - (b) Room rent is applicable only fro treatment procedures for which there is no UPRVUNL prescribed package rate.
 - (c) During the treatment in ICCU/ICU. no separate room rent will be admissible.
 - (d) Private Ward is defined as a hospital room where single patent is accommodated and which has an attached toilet (Lavatory or bath). The room should have furnishings like, bed-side table, as well as a bed for attendant.
 - (e) Semi Private ward is defined as a hospital room where two to three patients are accommodated and which has attached toilet facilities and necessary furnishings.
 - (f) General ward is defined as halls that accommodate four to ten patients.


If, on the request of the beneficiary, treatment is provided in a higher category of \ward, then the expenditure over and above entitlement will have to be borne by the beneficiary.



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5. During the inpatient treatment of the UPRVUNL beneficiary, the Hospital will not ask the beneficiary or his attendant to purchase separately the medicines, Sundries/equipment or accessories from outside and will provide the treatment within the package rate, fixed by the UPRVUNL which includes the cost of all the items, except those items which are Non reimbursable.
6. If one or more MAJOR/MINOR procedures form part of a major treatment procedure, then package charges would be permissible for Major procedure and only 50% of charges for MAJOR/MINOR.
7. Any legal liability arising out of such service shall be sole responsibility and shall be dealt with by the concerned empanelled hospital/Diagnostic centre. Services will be provided by the Hospitals/Diagnostic centers as per the terms of agreement.
8. The rates apply for only indoor treatment and some O.P.D. treatment as specified in Point No.9.
9. Outdoor treatment for Fractures (Only up to 15 days from the date of fracture). Dog and Monkey Bite. Cancer Chemo Therapy and Radio Therapy , Dialysis, Lithotripsy. Hearing-aid, Denture are permissible at NIGAM rates.
10. Any type of Cosmetic Surgery or Treatment is not reimbursable.
11. While Billing the Hospitals must clearly write the name of the procedure along with serial No. as given in the Rate list. No extra charge are to be levied apart from the Package Rates, otherwise strict action shall be taken against the Hospital, except for those investigation for which rates have not been fixed. They can be charged as per actual.
12. Above rates are for semi Private Ward. There will be a decrease of 10% in General Ward cases & an Increase of 10% in Private Ward case, only on Hospital services.
